- 1. Indiana ranks 5th in the nation for corn production
- 2. In the early 20th century, a farmer could hand pick approximately 100 bushels of corn in a 9 hour day. Today a combine can do this in 5 minutes.
- 3. In an ear of corn there will be one silk strand for each kernel.
- Corn is classified as a grass because you can cut it off and it will grow back.
- 5. An ear or cob of corn is actually the flower part of corn, and the individual kernels are the seeds.
- 6. An average ear of corn has 800 kernals
- 7. Corn is one of the most popular cereal grains in the world.
- 8. There are six major types of corn: dent corn (field corn); popcorn; sweet corn; flint corn (Indian corn); flour corn (one of the oldest kinds of corn); and pod corn (ornamental corn)
- 9. Corn syrup is a natural sweetener made from the starch of corn
- 10. There are over 3500 different uses for corn
- 11. One bushel of corn can sweeten 400 cans of soft drinks. Both soft drinks and juices often contain corn sweeteners as do many other foods.
- 12. One pound of corn consists of approximately 1300 kernels.
